# Youth Empowerment Project Public Service Announcement Competition Guidelines



#### **General Guidelines:**

### Competition entries must:

- Be submitted by youth 12-19 years old residing in Maricopa County.
- Be submitted in print ad or Web banner categories.
- Fit within format guidelines for the categories.
- · Include main messages about teen dating violence.
- Be submitted by an individual or a group (limit of 2).
- Be judged for inclusion of specified teen dating violence messages, clear visual concept, impact of concept, interest to teens, and creativity.

## **Entry Categories:**

- *Print:* Design a print ad to run in local newspapers and/or magazines in paper. The ad may also be used on other educational and promotional items for the *Web of Friends* Web site. These items may include *Web of Friends* cards, t-shirts, magnets, etc. Entries may be as simple as drawings or as elaborate as computer graphics. Print entries should be 8 ½ x 11.
- Web Banner: Design a Web banner for downloading onto Internet sites. The banner design may also be used on other educational and promotional items for the Web of Friends Web site. The banner may include animation and should be created as a half page ad (300 x 600 pixels or 3 ½ x 6 ½ in). Entries must be saved in one of the following formats: JPG, .GIF or .SWF (Flash) files and submitted electronically to <a href="mailto:rtenney@mag.maricopa.gov">rtenney@mag.maricopa.gov</a>.

#### **Main Messages:**

- Dating violence is never okay

- Pick one sign from any of the following categories to incorporate into your entry:
  - Healthy Relationships: Honesty, Trust
  - Cautionary Relationships: Insecurity, Jealousy
  - Unhealthy Relationships: Insults, Hitting
